



WRITE AND SAY: sound "m" /m/-letter M

Teddy is learning to write his letters so he can make the sound that goes with it! You will need a crayon or pencil.



1. Tell your child you will play a guessing game with Teddy. Ask the child to **guess where** on Teddy you will draw the letter (chin, nose, mouth, cheek, forehead, ear, etc.)
2. With a crayon or pencil, draw the letter M somewhere on Teddy. (You could also put it "over" "under" "next to" "above" "below" to make it extra tricky!) Did your child guess where you would put it?
3. Now it's your child's turn to ask you where s/he will put the letter. As the child writes the letter, tell her/him the letter M makes the "m" sound and make that sound together. Now take turns writing the letter M in the speech bubbles, guessing where each other will put it (use "next to," "above," "below" again!)
4. **Sign** this sheet with your child and send back to school so we can celebrate your work! As you write the letters, **stretch** each sound together.
